**VISION**: The vision for *A Family of Faith* is strong Catholic families in which children learn the joys of following Jesus Christ and the truths of their faith through the witness of Christian life given by their parents. **This program is designed for youth in grades K-8 along with their families. Young people in grades 6-8 will be introduced to Youth Ministry at the Friday Family Sessions!** 

**RATIONALE:** Effective and lasting faith formation must be anchored in family life. *Countless studies have shown that parental engagement with children is the single most effective way to develop young people into disciples of Christ.* Family-based models are fundamental to developing a faith life that is lived out in the family and in a community.

#### **GOALS:**

- To encourage and equip parents in their role in forming their children in the faith
- To support and nurture strong Catholic families
- To provide parents the opportunity for their own spiritual growth and knowledge
- To build a community whereby families can celebrate Catholic life together through common prayer, service to others, social activities, and liturgical celebrations

#### PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

A Family of Faith is a family-centered program designed with two sessions per month:

- 1. **An Adult Session** where adults gather with other parents/grandparents/caregivers, learn more about the material they will be covering with their families, grow in their own faith, and enjoy a supportive community.
- 2. **A Community Session** where families participate in prayer, service, social activities, and liturgical celebrations.

Between the meetings, parents/grandparents/caregivers work with their children on the material for that month in their *A Family of Faith* books at home.

#### FEATURES OF THE PROGRAM:

- Convenient One Book for the Whole Family: The content rotates on a four-year cycle so that on a given year, all family members explore the same material together.
- **Flexible and Individualized**: The program is designed with a Parent's Guidebook and a Youth Activity Book. The books are broken up into monthly units that include two lessons per month, with a selection of activities for each lesson. The intention is not to complete every activity, but to complete those activities that are most appropriate for each family.
- **Supportive Monthly Format:** Families are supported with the Adult Sessions that offer content that will be covered, and learning is reinforced in the monthly Community Session.

#### PROGRAM MATERIALS: ORDER MATERIALS ASAP to allow for shipping.

#### **SACREMANTAL PREPARATION AND MATERIALS:**

- 1. Materials for Sacramental Preparation will be distributed at our Adult Sessions.
  - a. **Reconciliation** (children in grades 2 and older and who are attending Mass and participating in the Family of Faith Program regularly)
  - b. <u>Confirmation and First Holy Communion</u> (children in grades 3 and older who are attending Mass and participating in the Family of Faith Program regularly) who have celebrated their First Reconciliation
- 2. Once Reconciliation materials are completed, the child will come for a practice session with Colleen and then arrange a time to celebrate his or her first Reconciliation with the pastor.
- 3. These materials are completed at home, and learning and preparation will be affirmed with a retreat experience in the early spring for Confirmation/First Communion.
